**Mikropatia - a one year long urban culture event.**

Mikropatia takes over the alleys and ice cream bars, gas stations and discount stores, retirement homes and harbors. Mikropatia spreads its microscopic tentacles all over the city and offers microsize spectacles during the whole cultural capital year 2011. The program contains at least 52 different shows and 365 performances.

What happens, for example, to a performance when being physically limited to the maximum size of 1 square meter? How does a massive micro theatre show look like? How about a one minute spectacle? How many stages fit into one window? And how can we through these small art pieces activate the soul of the city people, to attract attention to the beauty of the tiniest movements of life?



**The program of Mikropatia consists of four show categories:**

**Mikroilmasto** (micro climate) – for site specific micro theatre

**Mikropolis** – for politically oriented micro theatre

**Mikropiiri** (micro circle) – for community based micro theatre

**Mikromance** – for poetic micro theatre shows

The shows are mostly presented in public spaces, away from the the traditional theatre space and for free. The event is part of the official program of the Turku 2011 European Capital of Culture.
